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HOUSE BILL No. 5414

March 2, 2016, Introduced by Rep. Price and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1307e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1307E. THE STATE POLICY UNDER SECTION 1307A SHALL INCLUDE
- 2 AT LEAST ALL OF THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS CONCERNING DEVELOPMENT AND
- 3 IMPLEMENTATION OF AN EMERGENCY INTERVENTION PLAN:
- 4 (A) EACH INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL DEVELOP A WRITTEN
 - AND PUBLICLY AVAILABLE DISTRICTWIDE EMERGENCY INTERVENTION PLAN
- 6 THAT PROTECTS THE HEALTH, SAFETY, AND DIGNITY OF PUPILS. THE
- 7 EMERGENCY INTERVENTION PLAN SHALL PROVIDE A CLEAR AND DETAILED
- 8 DESCRIPTION OF THE PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED, AND THE POTENTIAL
- 9 ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN, IN AN EMERGENCY SITUATION, INCLUDING, IF
- 10 APPLICABLE, THE POTENTIAL USE OF EMERGENCY SECLUSION AND EMERGENCY
- 11 PHYSICAL RESTRAINT, ALONG WITH EXAMPLES OF SITUATIONS THAT COULD

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- 1 RESULT IN THE USE OF EMERGENCY SECLUSION OR EMERGENCY PHYSICAL
- 2 RESTRAINT. THE EMERGENCY INTERVENTION PLAN SHOULD BE DEVELOPED AND
- 3 PERIODICALLY REVISED IN PARTNERSHIP WITH PARENTS AND GUARDIANS BY A
- 4 TEAM THAT INCLUDES AN INDIVIDUAL KNOWLEDGEABLE ABOUT THE
- 5 APPROPRIATE USE OF EMERGENCY SECLUSION AND EMERGENCY PHYSICAL
- 6 RESTRAINT AND AN INDIVIDUAL KNOWLEDGEABLE ABOUT THE USE OF POSITIVE
- 7 BEHAVIORAL SUPPORTS TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE THE USE OF SECLUSION AND
- 8 RESTRAINT. THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL PROVIDE PARENTS
- 9 AND GUARDIANS WITH PAPER OR ELECTRONIC NOTICE OF THE AVAILABILITY
- 10 OF THE EMERGENCY INTERVENTION PLAN, INCLUDING INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW
- 11 TO ACCESS OR REQUEST A COPY OF THE PLAN AND A PROCESS FOR ASKING
- 12 OUESTIONS AND EXPRESSING CONCERNS. IF THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL
- 13 DISTRICT HAS A PUBLIC WEBSITE, THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT
- 14 SHALL POST THE EMERGENCY INTERVENTION PLAN ON THAT WEBSITE.
- 15 (B) IF CONCERNS ARISE REGARDING HUMANENESS OR SOCIAL
- 16 ACCEPTABILITY OF AN ELEMENT OF THE EMERGENCY INTERVENTION PLAN, THE
- 17 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT SHOULD CONVENE A HUMAN RIGHTS
- 18 COMMITTEE TO REVIEW THE EMERGENCY INTERVENTION PLAN. THE HUMAN
- 19 RIGHTS COMMITTEE SHOULD CONSIST OF AT LEAST 3 KEY IDENTIFIED
- 20 PERSONNEL AND 3 MEMBERS OF THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S
- 21 PARENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE. AS DEFINED IN THE EMERGENCY INTERVENTION
- 22 PLAN, THIS COMMITTEE SHOULD DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 23 (i) PROVIDE PERIODIC REVIEW OF THE PLAN AND RELATED DATA, AND
- 24 RECOMMEND REVISIONS TO THE PLAN, AS NEEDED.
- 25 (ii) ENSURE THAT KEY IDENTIFIED PERSONNEL ARE TRAINED IN THE
- 26 SPECIFIC TECHNIQUES DESCRIBED IN THE EMERGENCY INTERVENTION PLAN.
- 27 (iii) ENSURE THAT NECESSARY STAFFING IS MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES.
