THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:

2 (a) "Constitutional taking" or "taking" means the taking of
3 private property by government action such that compensation to the
4 owner of that property is required by either ANY of the following:

5 (i) Amendment V or XIV of the constitution of the United6 States.

7 (ii) Section 23 of article I and section 2 of article X of the8 state constitution of 1963.

9 (b) "Departments" means the departments DEPARTMENT of natural
10 resources, THE DEPARTMENT OF environmental quality, THE DEPARTMENT
11 OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT, and THE STATE transportation

DEPARTMENT. "DEPARTMENT" MEANS 1 OF THE DEPARTMENTS.

(c) "Government action" means any of the following:

3 (i) A decision on an application for a permit or license.

4 (*ii*) Proposed rules that if promulgated or enforced may limit5 the use of private property.

6 (*iii*) Required dedications or exactions of private property.

7 (*iv*) The enforcement of a statute or rule, including the8 issuance of an order.

9 (d) "Government action" does not include any of the following:

10 (i) The formal exercise of the power of eminent domain.

(*ii*) The forfeiture or seizure of private property by law
enforcement agencies as evidence of a crime or for violations of
law.

(*iii*) The discontinuance of government programs.

15 (e) "Rule" means a rule promulgated pursuant to the

16 administrative procedures act of 1969, Act No. 306 of the Public

17 Acts of 1969, being sections 24.201 to 24.328 of the Michigan

19 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days20 after the date it is enacted into law.
