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HOUSE BILL No. 5707

May 26, 2016, Introduced by Rep. Kosowski and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 634 (MCL 257.634), as amended by 1988 PA 346.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 634. (1) Upon each roadway of sufficient width, the driver of a vehicle shall drive the vehicle upon the right half of the roadway, except as follows:
 - (a) When overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction under the rules governing that movement.
 - (b) When the right half of a roadway is closed to traffic while under construction or repair or when an obstruction exists making it necessary to drive to the left of the center of the highway. A driver who is driving on the left half of a roadway under this subdivision shall yield the right-of-way to an oncoming

- 2 portion of the roadway.
- 3 (c) When a vehicle operated by a state agency or a local
- 4 authority or an agent of a state agency or local authority is
- 5 engaged in work on the roadway.
- 6 (d) Upon a roadway divided into 3 marked lanes for traffic
- 7 under the rules applicable on the roadway.
- 8 (2) Upon a roadway having 2 or more lanes for travel in 1
- 9 direction, the driver of a vehicle shall drive the vehicle in the
- 10 extreme right-hand lane available for travel except as otherwise
- 11 provided in this section. However, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION
- 12 (3), the driver of a vehicle may drive the vehicle in any lane
- 13 lawfully available to traffic moving in the same direction of
- 14 travel when the lanes are occupied by vehicles moving in
- 15 substantially continuous lanes of traffic. and in any left-hand
- 16 lane lawfully available to traffic moving in the same direction of
- 17 travel for a reasonable distance before making a left turn.
- 18 (3) UPON A ROADWAY HAVING 2 OR MORE LANES FOR TRAVEL IN 1
- 19 DIRECTION, THE DRIVER OF A VEHICLE IN THE EXTREME LEFT-HAND LANE
- 20 SHALL NOT CONTINUE TO OPERATE HIS OR HER VEHICLE IN THAT LANE IF HE
- 21 OR SHE KNOWS OR REASONABLY SHOULD KNOW THAT HE OR SHE IS BEING
- 22 OVERTAKEN IN THAT LANE FROM THE REAR BY A VEHICLE TRAVELING AT A
- 23 HIGHER RATE OF SPEED. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY UNDER ANY OF
- 24 THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:
- 25 (A) TRAFFIC CONDITIONS, INCLEMENT WEATHER, OBSTRUCTIONS,
- 26 HAZARDS, OR COMPLIANCE WITH A LAW OF THIS STATE OR AN OFFICIAL
- 27 TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE MAKE IT NECESSARY TO DRIVE IN THE EXTREME

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- 1 LEFT-HAND LANE.
- 2 (B) THE VEHICLE IS REQUIRED TO BE DRIVEN IN THE EXTREME LEFT-
- 3 HAND LANE IN ORDER TO EXIT OR TURN LEFT.
- 4 (C) THE VEHICLE IS AN AUTHORIZED EMERGENCY VEHICLE.
- 5 (D) THE VEHICLE IS A ROAD MAINTENANCE VEHICLE ENGAGED IN ROAD
- 6 CONSTRUCTION OR MAINTENANCE. AS USED IN THIS SUBDIVISION, "ROAD
- 7 MAINTENANCE VEHICLE" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 653B.
- 8 (4) (3) This section shall DOES not be construed to prohibit a
- 9 vehicle traveling in the appropriate direction from traveling in
- 10 any lane of a freeway having 3 or more lanes for travel in the same
- 11 direction. However, a city, village, township, or county may not
- 12 enact an ordinance which THAT regulates the same subject matter as
- 13 any provision of this subsection. The driver of a truck with a
- 14 gross weight of more than 10,000 pounds, a truck tractor, or a
- 15 combination of a vehicle and trailer or semitrailer shall drive the
- 16 vehicle or combination of vehicles only in either of the 2 lanes
- 17 farthest to the right, except for a reasonable distance when making
- 18 a left turn or where a special hazard exists that requires the use
- 19 of an alternative lane for safety reasons.
- 20 (5) (4)—A person who violates this section is responsible for
- 21 a civil infraction.
- 22 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 23 after the date it is enacted into law.
