HOUSE BILL No. 5904

September 21, 2016, Introduced by Rep. Muxlow and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled

"The revised school code,"

by amending section 1233 (MCL 380.1233), as amended by 2016 PA 192.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1233. (1) Except as otherwise provided by law, and
 subject to section 1233c, the board of a school district or
 intermediate school board of an intermediate school district shall
 not permit a teacher who does not hold a valid teaching certificate
 to teach in a grade or department of the school.

6 (2) The board of a school district or intermediate school
7 board of an intermediate school district shall not allow an
8 individual to serve in a counseling role in the school district or
9 intermediate school district, as the role is defined by the

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superintendent of public instruction, unless the individual meets 1
or more of the following and the board or intermediate school board
complies with subsection (7):

4 (a) The individual holds a valid teaching certificate with a5 school counseling endorsement.

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(b) The individual meets all of the following:

7 (i) Holds a master's degree awarded after completion of an
8 approved school counselor education program that includes at least
9 all of the following skills and content areas or their equivalent:

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(A) Guidance services--philosophy, principles, and practices.

(B) Individual and group analysis--nature and range of humancharacteristics and appraisal methods.

13 (C) Guidance information--vocational development theory,14 educational and occupational information.

(D) Counseling theory and practice--individual and group
procedures, administration and coordination relationships,
professional relationships, and ethics.

18 (E) Supervised experiences--laboratory, practicum, or19 internship.

20 (F) Evaluation--statistics and research methodology, follow-up21 evaluation, and measurement methods.

22 (*ii*) Has successfully completed the department's guidance23 counselor examination.

24 (iii) Has been recommended by an approved school counselor25 education program to provide services as a school counselor.

- 26 (c) The individual meets both of the following:
- 27 (i) Has at least 5 years of successful experience serving in a

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school counseling role in another state within the immediately
 preceding 7-year period.

3 (ii) Has successfully completed the department's guidance4 counselor examination.

5 (3) Except for teachers engaged to teach in a community district under section 1233c, the intermediate superintendent shall 6 7 notify the superintendent of public instruction immediately of the names of noncertificated teachers teaching in violation of 8 subsection (1) and the names of individuals serving in counseling 9 10 roles in violation of subsection (2), the employing district, and 11 the amount of time the noncertificated teachers or unqualified 12 individuals were employed.

(4) A vocational teacher preparation institution shall utilize the employment experience of an annually authorized teacher for the purpose of waiving student teaching as a requirement for vocational certification if the annually authorized teacher is supervised by the teacher preparation institution.

18 (5) All vocational education teachers certified after June 1,19 1995 shall pass a competency test.

(6) The board of a school district or intermediate school
district may employ an individual without a teaching certificate as
a substitute teacher if the individual has at least 90–60 semester
hours of college credit from a college or university. THE
DEPARTMENT SHALL AMEND ANY APPLICABLE RULE AS NECESSARY TO BE
CONSISTENT WITH THIS SUBSECTION.

26 (7) If the board of a school district or intermediate school27 board of an intermediate school district chooses to employ an

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individual who does not hold a valid teaching certificate to serve in a counseling role, as permitted under subsection (2), the school board or intermediate school board shall comply with sections 1230 and 1230a with respect to that individual to the same extent as required for employing an individual with a teaching certificate to serve as a teacher.

7 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days8 after the date it is enacted into law.

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
