A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled

"Revised judicature act of 1961,"

by amending section 2157a (MCL 600.2157a), as added by 1984 PA 340.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2157a. (1) For purposes of this section:
- 2 (a) "Confidential communication" means information transmitted
- 3 between a victim and a sexual assault, or domestic violence, OR
- 4 HUMAN TRAFFICKING counselor, or between a victim or sexual assault,
- 5 or domestic violence, OR HUMAN TRAFFICKING counselor and any other
- 6 person to whom disclosure is reasonably necessary to further the
- 7 interests of the victim, in connection with the rendering of
- 8 advice, counseling, or other assistance by the sexual assault, or
- 9 domestic violence, OR HUMAN TRAFFICKING counselor to the victim.
- 10 (b) "Domestic violence" means that term as defined in section

- 8 PROVIDING ADVICE, COUNSELING, OR OTHER ASSISTANCE TO VICTIMS OF

- 10 (E) (c) "Sexual assault" means assault with intent to commit
- 11 criminal sexual conduct.
- 12 (F) (d)—"Sexual assault or domestic violence counselor" means
- 13 a person who is employed at or who volunteers service at a sexual

- 15 capacity provides advice, counseling, or other assistance to

- 6 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 7 after the date it is enacted into law.
