HOUSE BILL No. 5978

October 19, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Sarah Roberts and Irwin and referred to the Committee on Energy Policy.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 61506d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 61506D. (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE AS A CONDITION
- 2 OF A PERMIT ISSUED UNDER THIS PART OR ANY OTHER AUTHORIZATION TO
- 3 USE AN OIL OR GAS WELL FOR HYDRAULIC FRACTURING THAT THE PERMIT
- 4 HOLDER IS PROHIBITED FROM INJECTING ANY WATER OR OTHER SUBSTANCE
- 5 USED IN THE HYDRAULIC FRACTURING PROCESS INTO AN AQUIFER.
- 6 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 7 (A) "AQUIFER" MEANS ANY WATER-BEARING BED OR STRATUM OF EARTH
- 8 OR ROCK CAPABLE OF YIELDING GROUNDWATER TO A WATER WELL IN
- 9 SUFFICIENT QUANTITIES THAT CAN BE WITHDRAWN.

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- 1 (B) "HYDRAULIC FRACTURING" MEANS INJECTING SUBSTANCES
- 2 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, WATER, FLUIDS, CHEMICALS, FOAM, AND
- 3 PROPPANTS INTO A WELL OR A ROCK FORMATION UNDER HIGH PRESSURE TO
- 4 CREATE FRACTURES, FOR PURPOSES OF EXPLORATION, DRILLING,
- 5 COMPLETION, OR PRODUCTION OF OIL, NATURAL GAS, OR HYDROCARBONS OR
- 6 TO ENHANCE THE PRODUCTION OF OIL, NATURAL GAS, OR HYDROCARBONS.
- 7 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 8 after the date it is enacted into law.
