## **HOUSE BILL No. 5999**

October 19, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Hoadley and Wittenberg and referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
by amending section 223 (MCL 750.223), as amended by 2012 PA 242.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 223. (1) A person who knowingly sells a pistol without 2 complying with section 2 of 1927 PA 372, MCL 28.422, is guilty of a 3 misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, 4 or a fine of not more than \$100.00, or both. 5 (2) A person who knowingly sells a firearm more than 26 inches in length to a person under 18 years of age is guilty of a 6 7 misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or a fine of not more than \$500.00, or both. A second or subsequent 8 9 violation of this subsection is a felony punishable by imprisonment 10 for not more than 4 years, or a fine of not more than \$2,000.00, or 11 both. It is an affirmative defense to a prosecution under this

- 2 was shown a driver's license or identification card issued by a

- 5 (3) A seller shall not sell a firearm or ammunition to a
