HOUSE BILL No. 6065

November 29, 2016, Introduced by Rep. Singh and referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice.

A bill to amend 1937 PA 10, entitled

"An act to define the use of travel aids by blind persons; to provide protection against accidents to such persons; to require instruction and examination in certain circumstances; and to provide penalties for violation hereof,"

by amending sections 1a and 3 (MCL 752.51a and 752.53), section 1a as amended by 2002 PA 401 and section 3 as amended by 1986 PA 62.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1a. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Blind" means a person who has a visual acuity of 20/200
- 3 or less in the better eye with correction, or has limitation of his
- 4 or her field of vision such that the widest diameter of the visual
- 5 field subtends an angular distance not greater than 20 degrees.
- 6 (b) "Cane" means an aid used by a blind pedestrian for travel
- 7 and identification purposes that is PREDOMINANTLY white OR METALLIC
- 8 in color with or without a red tip.

- 1 (c) "Crosswalk" means that term as defined in section 10 of
- 2 the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.10.
- 3 (d) "Dog guide" means a dog, in harness, that has been
- 4 formally trained and that is used by a blind person as a travel
- 5 aid.
- 6 (e) "Walker" means an aid used by a blind pedestrian for
- 7 travel and identification purposes that is white in color or has
- 8 white legs with or without a red tip.
- 9 Sec. 3. (1) A person who violates section 2(1) is guilty of a
- 10 misdemeanor —punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days
- 11 __or by a fine of not more_LESS than \$100.00 AND NOT MORE THAN
- 12 \$500.00, or both.
- 13 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SECTION 2(1) CAUSING INJURY OF A
- 14 BLIND PERSON IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT
- 15 FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR
- 16 BOTH.
- 17 (3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SECTION 2(1) CAUSING THE DEATH OF A
- 18 BLIND PERSON IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR
- 19 NOT MORE THAN 15 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$7,500.00, OR
- 20 BOTH.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 22 after the date it is enacted into law.
