March 5, 2015, Introduced by Senators STAMAS, PROOS, KNEZEK, SCHMIDT, BRANDENBURG, HOPGOOD, GREEN, CASPERSON, BOOHER and JONES and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding sections 811cc, 811dd, 811ee, 811ff, and 811qq.

- 3 MICHIGAN INTERNATIONAL SPEEDWAY SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY OF
- 4 STATE. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL CONFER WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF

- 13 THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM ANY
- 14 SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT
- 15 THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE

- 26 BEGINNING NOT LATER THAN 1 YEAR AFTER THE SECRETARY OF STATE ISSUES
- 27 THE FUND-RAISING PLATE DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION AND ANNUALLY

- 1 THEREAFTER, MIS CARES SHALL SUBMIT TO THE STATE TREASURER A SUMMARY
- 2 OF THE EXPENDITURES DURING THE PRECEDING YEAR OF THE MONEY RECEIVED
- 3 UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 5 after the date it is enacted into law.
