A bill to amend 1945 PA 327, entitled "Aeronautics code of the state of Michigan," (MCL 259.1 to 259.208) by adding section 96.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

SEC. 96. (1) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS OPERATING A DRONE SHALL NOT
FLY THE DRONE TO WITHIN 1,000 FEET OF THE MACKINAC BRIDGE.
