THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

SEC. 483C. IF AN INDIVIDUAL RECEIVES COMPENSATION TO CIRCULATE

2 A PETITION DESCRIBED IN SECTION 482, THEN THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL,

3 WHEN CIRCULATING THE PETITION FOR SIGNATURES, WEAR AN

4 IDENTIFICATION BADGE THAT DOES BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:

(A) IDENTIFIES THE INDIVIDUAL AS A PAID PETITION CIRCULATOR.

(B) IDENTIFIES THE PERSON OR ENTITY PAYING THE CIRCULATOR.

SEC. 957B. IF AN INDIVIDUAL RECEIVES COMPENSATION TO CIRCULATE A RECALL PETITION UNDER THIS CHAPTER, THEN THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL, WHEN CIRCULATING THE RECALL PETITION FOR SIGNATURES, WEAR AN
