## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4319

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 803f (MCL 257.803f), as amended by 1998 PA 68.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 803f. (1) A person who is a totally disabled veteran with
- 2 an honorable discharge from the armed services may make an
- 3 application to the secretary of state if he or she owns a private
- 4 passenger motor vehicle, and the secretary of state may issue a
- 5 special registration plate which shall be inscribed with special
- 6 identification numbers preceded by the letters "DV" and shall have
- 7 the words "disabled veteran" inscribed beneath the registration
- 8 number. For the purposes of this section, "private passenger motor
- 9 vehicle" means a motor vehicle which THAT is personally owned by
- 10 the disabled veteran and is used for the primary purpose of

- 1 transporting the disabled veteran and family members of the
- 2 disabled veteran, but does not include a motor home.
- 3 (2) Application for the special registration plate shall MUST
- 4 be on a form prescribed by the secretary of state , and shall MUST
- 5 be accompanied by a service fee of \$5.00 and proof that the
- 6 applicant was honorably discharged from the armed services and
- 7 either 1 of the following:
- 8 (a) That the applicant has been determined by the veterans!
- 9 administration of the federal government UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT
- 10 OF VETERANS AFFAIRS to have a service-connected total or permanent
- 11 total disability rating for compensation.
- 12 (b) That the applicant has been determined to have a service-
- 13 connected total or permanent total disability rating and is
- 14 receiving disability retirement pay from a branch of the uniformed
- 15 armed services.
- 16 (3) A special registration issued under this section is exempt
- 17 from payment of the tax provided in section 801.
- 18 (4) The special registration plate shall expire EXPIRES on the
- 19 birthday of the disabled veteran in a year in which new plates are
- 20 issued by the secretary of state. Application for renewal of the
- 21 special registration plate shall MUST be accompanied by a \$5.00
- 22 service fee. The applicant shall not be required to furnish the
- 23 proof provided in subsection (2).
- 24 (5) THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A PERSON WHO IS A TOTALLY DISABLED
- 25 VETERAN WITH AN HONORABLE DISCHARGE FROM THE ARMED SERVICES MAY USE
- 26 A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION AFTER THE
- 27 DEATH OF THE TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN AND MAY RENEW A SPECIAL

- 1 REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION AFTER THE DEATH OF THE
- 2 TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN IN THE SAME MANNER AS PROVIDED UNDER THIS
- 3 SECTION FOR A TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN. IF APPLICABLE, A SURVIVING
- 4 SPOUSE SHALL APPLY FOR REGISTRATION OF THE VEHICLE UPON WHICH HE OR
- 5 SHE WISHES TO PLACE THE DISABLED VETERAN PLATE BEFORE USING OR
- 6 RENEWING THE PLATE AS DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION.
- 7 (6) (5) The secretary of state may issue to a disabled person
- 8 who has been issued a special registration plate under this section
- 9 a tab for persons with disabilities. The tab for persons with
- 10 disabilities shall MUST be an adhesive tab displaying the
- 11 international wheelchair symbol or a reasonable facsimile of that
- 12 symbol. The tab for persons with disabilities may be attached only
- 13 to the special registration plate issued to the disabled person
- 14 under this section.
- 15 (7) (6) An application for a tab for persons with disabilities
- 16 shall be on a form prescribed by the secretary of state. The
- 17 secretary of state shall require the same proof that the applicant
- 18 is a disabled person as is required for issuance of a permanent
- 19 windshield placard under section 675. IF THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A
- 20 TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN IS A DISABLED PERSON, HE OR SHE MAY APPLY
- 21 TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR A TAB FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES
- 22 IN THE SAME MANNER AS PROVIDED FOR A TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN UNDER
- 23 THIS SUBSECTION.
- 24 (8) (7) The tab for persons with disabilities shall MUST be
- 25 issued free of charge.
- 26 (9) (8) When a disabled person who has been issued a tab for
- 27 persons with disabilities renews his or her special registration

- 1 plate under this section, the secretary of state shall issue a new
- 2 tab for persons with disabilities to the disabled person, free of
- 3 charge. The disabled person shall not be required to again furnish
- 4 the proof required under subsection (6).(7).
- 5 (10) (9) The use of the special registration plate or a tab
- 6 for persons with disabilities on a motor vehicle other than the
- 7 motor vehicle for which the special registration plate is issued,
- 8 or by a person who does not qualify under this section, is a
- 9 misdemeanor.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 180 days
- 11 after the date it is enacted into law.
