A bill to amend 1846 RS 16, entitled

"Of the powers and duties of townships, the election and duties of township officers, and the division of townships,"

(MCL 41.1a to 41.110c) by adding section 72c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 72C. THE TOWNSHIP BOARD, BY VOTE OF NOT LESS THAN 2
- 2 MEMBERS, MAY COMPEL THE ATTENDANCE OF BOARD MEMBERS AND OTHER
- 3 OFFICERS OF THE TOWNSHIP AT A REGULAR OR SPECIAL MEETING AND
- 4 ENFORCE ORDERLY CONDUCT IN THE MEETING. A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OR
- 5 ANY OTHER OFFICER OF THE TOWNSHIP WHO REFUSES TO ATTEND A MEETING
- 6 OR CONDUCT HIMSELF OR HERSELF IN AN ORDERLY MANNER IS GUILTY OF
- 7 MISCONDUCT IN OFFICE.
