SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 502

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 803f (MCL 257.803f), as amended by 1998 PA 68.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 803f. (1) A person who is a totally disabled veteran with 2 an honorable discharge from the armed services may make an 3 application to the secretary of state if he or she owns a private passenger motor vehicle, and the secretary of state may issue a 4 special registration plate which shall be inscribed with special 5 identification numbers preceded by the letters "DV" and shall have 6 the words "disabled veteran" inscribed beneath the registration 7 8 number. For the purposes of AS USED IN this section, "private 9 passenger motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle which THAT is 10 personally owned by the A disabled veteran and is used for the 11 primary purpose of transporting the disabled veteran and HIS OR HER

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family members, of the disabled veteran, but does not include a
 motor home.

3 (2) Application AN APPLICATION for the special registration
4 plate DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) shall be on a form prescribed by
5 the secretary of state — and shall be accompanied by a service fee
6 of \$5.00 and proof that the applicant was honorably discharged from
7 the armed services and either 1 of the following:

8 (a) That IF THE APPLICANT IS A TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN, THAT
9 the applicant has been determined by the veterans' administration
10 of the federal government to have a service-connected total or
11 permanent total disability rating for compensation.

(b) That—IF THE APPLICANT IS A TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN, THAT
the applicant has been determined to have a service-connected total
or permanent total disability rating and is receiving disability
retirement pay from a branch of the uniformed armed services.

16 (C) IF THE APPLICANT IS A PARTIALLY DISABLED VETERAN, THAT THE 17 APPLICANT HAS BEEN DETERMINED TO HAVE A SERVICE-CONNECTED 18 DISABILITY RATING.

19 (3) A special registration issued under this section is exempt
20 from payment of the tax provided FOR in section 801. THIS
21 SUBSECTION ONLY APPLIES TO A TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN DESCRIBED IN
22 SUBSECTION (2) (A) OR (B).

(4) The A special registration plate shall expire ISSUED TO A
TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2) (A) OR (B)
UNDER THIS SECTION EXPIRES on the birthday of the TOTALLY disabled
veteran in a year in which new plates are issued by the secretary
of state. Application for renewal of the special registration plate

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shall be accompanied by a \$5.00 service fee. The applicant shall
 not be required to furnish the proof provided in subsection (2).

3 (5) A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED TO A PARTIALLY
4 DISABLED VETERAN DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2) (C) EXPIRES AS PROVIDED
5 IN SECTION 226, AND A PARTIALLY DISABLED VETERAN SHALL APPLY FOR
6 RENEWAL OF THE SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE AS PROVIDED IN SECTION
7 226. THE APPLICANT SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO FURNISH THE PROOF
8 PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2).

9 (6) (5) The IF APPLICABLE, THE secretary of state may issue to 10 a disabled person VETERAN who has been issued a special 11 registration plate under this section a tab for persons with 12 disabilities. The tab for persons with disabilities shall be an 13 adhesive tab displaying the international wheelchair symbol or a 14 reasonable facsimile of that symbol. The tab for persons with 15 disabilities may be attached only to the special registration plate issued to the disabled person VETERAN under this section. 16

17 (7) (6) An application for a tab for persons with disabilities 18 shall be on a form prescribed by the secretary of state. The 19 secretary of state shall require the same proof that the applicant 20 is a disabled person as is required for issuance of a permanent 21 windshield placard under section 675.

22 (8) (7) The A tab for persons with disabilities ISSUED UNDER
23 SUBSECTION (6) shall be issued free of charge.

(9) (8) When a disabled person VETERAN who has been issued a
tab for persons with disabilities renews his or her special
registration plate under this section, the secretary of state shall
issue a new tab for persons with disabilities to the disabled

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person, VETERAN, free of charge. The disabled person VETERAN shall not be required to again furnish the proof required under subsection (6).(7).

4 (10) (9) The use of the special registration plate or a tab
5 for persons with disabilities on a motor vehicle other than the
6 motor vehicle for which the special registration plate is issued,
7 or by a person who does not qualify under this section, is a
8 misdemeanor.

9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect August 1,10 2019.

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
