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HOUSE BILL No. 4009

January 11, 2017, Introduced by Rep. Lucido and referred to the Committee on Families, Children, and Seniors.

A bill to amend 1973 PA 116, entitled

"An act to provide for the protection of children through the licensing and regulation of child care organizations; to provide for the establishment of standards of care for child care organizations; to prescribe powers and duties of certain departments of this state and adoption facilitators; to provide penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

by amending sections 3 and 11b (MCL 722.113 and 722.121b), section 3 as amended by 2006 PA 206 and section 11b as amended by 2010 PA 86.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 3. (1) The rules promulgated by the department **OR THE DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS** under this act shall be used by the department, of community health, THE DEPARTMENT OF **LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS**, the bureau of fire services, and local authorities in the inspection of and reporting on child care organizations covered by this act. The inspection of the health and

- 1 fire safety of child care organizations shall be completed by
- 2 department staff or by the department of community health,
- 3 LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS, the bureau of fire services, or
- 4 local authorities upon request of the department, THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 5 LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS, or pursuant ACCORDING to
- 6 subsection (2).
- 7 (2) If an inspection is not conducted pursuant ACCORDING to
- 8 subsection (1), a person owning or operating or who proposes to own
- 9 or operate a child care organization may enter a contract with a
- 10 local authority or other person qualified to conduct an inspection
- 11 pursuant ACCORDING to subsection (1) and pay for that inspection
- 12 after an inspection is completed pursuant to UNDER this subsection.
- 13 A person may receive a provisional license if the proposed child
- 14 care organization passes the inspection, and the other requirements
- 15 of this act are met.
- 16 (3) The rules promulgated by the department for foster family
- 17 homes and foster family group homes shall be used by a licensed
- 18 child placing agency or an approved governmental unit when
- 19 investigating and certifying a foster family home or a foster
- 20 family group home.
- 21 (4) Inspection reports completed by state agencies, local
- 22 authorities, and child placing agencies shall be furnished to the
- 23 department AND THE DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS
- 24 and shall become a part of its evaluation for licensing of
- 25 organizations covered by this act. After careful consideration of
- 26 the reports and consultation where necessary, the department OR THE
- 27 DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS shall assume

- 1 responsibility for the final determination of the issuance, denial,
- 2 revocation, or provisional nature of licenses issued to
- 3 nongovernmental organizations. A report of findings shall be
- 4 furnished to the licensee. A license shall be issued to a specific
- 5 person or organization at a specific location, shall be IS
- 6 nontransferable, and shall remain REMAINS the property of the
- 7 department OR THE DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS.
- 8 (5) THE DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS MAY USE
- 9 THE INFORMATION OBTAINED IN SUBSECTION (4) FOR THE PURPOSE OF
- 10 MAINTAINING AND UPDATING THE DATABASE ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 11B.
- 11 Sec. 11b. (1) The department OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY
- 12 AFFAIRS shall establish and maintain a database of child care
- 13 centers, family child care homes, and group child care homes as a
- 14 central clearinghouse for persons seeking information on child care
- 15 options. The database shall include, at a minimum, all of the
- 16 following information:
- 17 (a) The name, address, and telephone number of the child care
- 18 center, family child care home, or group child care home.
- 19 (b) The days and general hours of operation of the child care
- 20 center, family child care home, or group child care home.
- 21 (c) The license **NUMBER** or registration number, effective date,
- 22 and expiration date of the LICENSE OR REGISTRATION OF THE child
- 23 care center, family child care home, or group child care home.
- 24 (D) A LIST OF ANY AND ALL OF THE CHILD CARE CENTER'S, FAMILY
- 25 CHILD CARE HOME'S, OR GROUP CHILD CARE HOME'S VIOLATIONS OF THIS
- 26 ACT, THE RULES PROMULGATED UNDER THIS ACT, OR THE TERMS OF A
- 27 LICENSE OR REGISTRATION.

- (E) (d) The number and nature of any adverse action taken
 against the child care center, family child care home, or group
- 3 child care home by the department OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY
- 4 AFFAIRS.
- 5 (F) (e) The number and nature of any special investigations
- 6 regarding the child care center, family child care home, or group
- 7 child care home conducted by the department that the department
- 8 classifies as high risk. This information shall remain in the
- 9 database as long as the licensee or registrant is licensed or
- 10 registered under this act. For the purpose of this subdivision,
- 11 "special investigation that the department classifies as high risk"
- 12 means an investigation in which the department becomes aware that 1
- 13 or more of the conditions listed in section 8(3)(a) to (c) of the
- 14 child protection law, 1975 PA 238, MCL 722.628, exist.
- (G) (f) Information that, upon completion of a special
- 16 investigation as described in subdivision (e), (F), the department
- 17 made a determination that there were no substantiated rule
- 18 violations. This information may be included in the same manner as
- 19 information provided under section 3f(5).
- 20 (2) The department OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS shall
- 21 make the database available to the public on the internet, without
- 22 charge, through that department's website.
- 23 (3) The department OF LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS shall
- 24 inform the public, through press releases or other media avenues,
- 25 of the information available in the database established under
- 26 subsection (1) and how to access that database.
- 27 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days

1 after the date it is enacted into law.
