HOUSE BILL No. 4579

May 3, 2017, Introduced by Rep. Kosowski and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to establish a stipend program for certain student teachers; to establish a student teacher stipend fund and to provide for its administration; and to prescribe certain powers and duties of certain state officers, agencies, and departments.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
 "student teacher stipend act".
- 3 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Authority" means the Michigan finance authority created within the department by Executive Reorganization Order No. 2010-2, MCL 12.194.
 - (b) "Department" means the department of treasury.
- (c) "Fund" means the student teacher stipend fund created in section 11.

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- 1 (d) "Public school" means that term as defined in section 5 of
- 2 the revised school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.5.
- 3 (e) "Stipend" means money awarded to an individual under this
- 4 act in an amount determined under section 9.
- 5 (f) "Student teacher" means an individual who meets all of the
- 6 following:
- 7 (i) Is a student enrolled in a teacher preparation institution
- 8 approved by the state pursuant to section 1538a of the revised
- 9 school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.1538a.
- 10 (ii) Is studying to be a teacher at the institution described
- 11 in subparagraph (i) in a program approved by the state pursuant to
- 12 section 1538a of the revised school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL
- **13** 380.1538a.
- 14 (iii) As a required part of the program described in
- 15 subparagraph (ii), observes classroom instruction or does closely
- 16 supervised teaching in a public school for at least 3 hours per
- **17** day.
- 18 Sec. 5. The student teacher stipend program is created within
- 19 the department, to be administered by the authority. Subject to
- 20 appropriation, the authority shall do all of the following:
- 21 (a) Award stipends to eligible student teachers under this
- **22** act.
- 23 (b) Develop an application form and application process for
- 24 student teachers applying for stipends under this act.
- 25 (c) Promulgate any rules necessary to implement this act
- 26 pursuant to the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306,
- 27 MCL 24.201 to 24.328.

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- 1 Sec. 7. The authority may award a stipend under section 9 to
- 2 an individual determined by the authority to meet all of the
- 3 following eligibility criteria:
- 4 (a) Is a student teacher.
- 5 (b) Is a legal resident of this state.
- 6 (c) Has submitted a stipend application to the authority on or
- 7 before a date prescribed by the authority. The stipend application
- 8 must include a certification that the applicant meets the
- 9 eligibility criteria described in this section.
- (d) Meets any other requirements established by the authority.
- 11 Sec. 9. (1) The authority shall award an individual eligible
- 12 under section 7 a stipend under this subsection. Subject to
- 13 adjustment under subsection (2), the maximum amount of the stipend
- 14 is \$40.00 per day that the individual serves as a student teacher.
- 15 (2) In any state fiscal year, the authority may adjust the
- 16 amount of each stipend under subsection (1) based upon its
- 17 determination of money available from the fund and from
- 18 appropriations in that fiscal year.
- 19 Sec. 11. (1) There is created the student teacher stipend fund
- 20 as a separate fund in the state treasury, to be administered by the
- 21 department. The department may accept money for the fund from any
- 22 source except the school aid fund created in section 11 of article
- 23 IX of the state constitution of 1963. The state treasurer shall
- 24 deposit that money and credit the amount to the fund. The
- 25 department shall use the fund only to provide money to the
- 26 authority for stipends awarded under this act.
- 27 (2) The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the

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- 1 fund money and shall credit earnings to the fund.
- 2 (3) Money in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not
- 3 revert to the general fund but shall be carried over in the fund to
- 4 the next fiscal year.
- 5 Sec. 13. Before February 1 of each year, the authority shall
- 6 report to the senate and house committees that have the
- 7 responsibility for education legislation all of the following:
- 8 (a) The number of individuals who received a stipend under
- 9 this act.
- 10 (b) A list of the public schools at which stipend recipients
- 11 served as student teachers.
- 12 (c) A list of institutions at which stipend recipients were
- 13 studying to become teachers.
- 14 (d) The average total amount paid to each stipend recipient.
- 15 (e) Any other data to support the operation and effectiveness
- 16 of the program.
- 17 Sec. 15. A recipient of a stipend under this act who submits a
- 18 false or misleading application or other false or misleading
- 19 information to the authority may be required to repay the total
- 20 amount of the stipend that he or she received, plus interest in
- 21 accordance with section 23 of 1941 PA 122, MCL 205.23.
