HOUSE BILL No. 5003

September 26, 2017, Introduced by Rep. Schor and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 637 (MCL 257.637).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 637. (1) The driver of a vehicle may overtake and pass upon the right of another vehicle only if 1 or more of the following conditions exist:
 - (a) When the vehicle overtaken is making or about to make a left turn.
 - (b) Upon a street or highway with unobstructed pavement not occupied by parked vehicles of sufficient width for 2 or more lines of moving vehicles in each direction and when the vehicles are moving in substantially continuous lanes of traffic.

- 1 (c) Upon a 1-way street, or upon a roadway on which traffic is
- 2 restricted to 1 direction of movement, where the roadway is free
- 3 from obstructions and of sufficient width for 2 or more lines of
- 4 moving vehicles and when the vehicles are moving in substantially
- 5 continuous lanes of traffic.
- 6 (2) The driver of a vehicle may overtake and pass another
- 7 vehicle upon the right only under conditions permitting the
- 8 overtaking and passing in safety. The driver of a vehicle shall not
- 9 overtake and pass another vehicle upon the right by driving off the
- 10 pavement or main-traveled portion of the roadway.
- 11 (3) THE DRIVER OF A VEHICLE OVERTAKING A BICYCLE SHALL, WHEN
- 12 OTHERWISE PERMITTED BY THIS SECTION, PASS AT A SAFE DISTANCE OF AT
- 13 LEAST 5 FEET TO THE RIGHT OF THAT BICYCLE.
- 14 (4) (3)—A person who violates this section is responsible for
- 15 a civil infraction.
- 16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 17 after the date it is enacted into law.
