

HOUSE BILL No. 5029

September 27, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Guerra, Hughes, Lucido, Brann, Sowerby, Pagan, Maturen, Wittenberg, Ellison, Noble, Sabo, Liberati, Chang, Yaroch, Farrington, Lasinski, Geiss, Camilleri and Schor and referred to the Committee on Law and Justice.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure," by amending section 16i of chapter XVII (MCL 777.16i), as amended by 2012 PA 169.
