

HOUSE BILL No. 6321

September 5, 2018, Introduced by Rep. Brinks and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 12722.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 **SEC. 12722. (1) IF THE DEPARTMENT BECOMES AWARE THAT PFAS HAVE**
2 **BEEN DETECTED IN A PRIVATE DRINKING WATER WELL, THE DEPARTMENT**
3 **SHALL NOTIFY ALL OWNERS OF REAL PROPERTY THAT DRAW WATER FROM THE**
4 **AQUIFER IN WHICH PFAS HAVE BEEN DETECTED AND SHALL PROVIDE**
5 **EDUCATIONAL INFORMATION, PREPARED BY THE DEPARTMENT, THAT INCLUDES**
6 **AT LEAST ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:**

7 **(A) WHAT PFAS ARE AND HOW THEY CAN BECOME PRESENT IN**
8 **GROUNDWATER.**

9 **(B) POTENTIAL HEALTH RISKS FROM PFAS.**

10 **(C) INFORMATION REGARDING HOW THE INDIVIDUAL MAY OBTAIN**

1 ADDITIONAL TESTING OF WATER AT HIS OR HER PROPERTY.

2 (D) OTHER RESOURCES IDENTIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT THAT ARE
3 PERTINENT TO PFAS.

4 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "PFAS" MEANS PERFLUOROALKYL OR
5 POLYFLUOROALKYL SUBSTANCES. PFAS INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO,
6 PFOA AND PFOS.

7 (A) "PFOA" MEANS PERFLUOROOCTANOIC ACID.

8 (B) "PFOS" MEANS PERFLUOROOCTANE SULFONIC ACID.
