

SENATE BILL No. 298

April 18, 2017, Introduced by Senators HERTEL, CONYERS, STAMAS, BIEDA, WARREN, YOUNG and PROOS and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to designate the black swallowtail butterfly as the official butterfly of the state of Michigan.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. The black swallowtail butterfly (*Papilio polyxenes*) is
2 designated as this state's official state butterfly.

3 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
4 date it is enacted into law.
