## **SENATE BILL No. 1032**

May 29, 2018, Introduced by Senator JONES and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to require the reporting of credible threats against public and nonpublic schools.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. (1) An individual required to report child abuse or child neglect under section 3 of the child protection law, 1975 PA 3 238, MCL 722.623, is also required to report when he or she learns of a credible threat against a public school or nonpublic school. The report must be made immediately to a law enforcement agency.
  - (2) As used in this section:
    - (a) "Credible threat" means a verbal or nonverbal threat, or a combination of the 2, including a threat delivered by electronic communication, that places the individual or group of individuals who are the target of the threat in reasonable fear for his or her

- 2 threat is made with the apparent ability to carry out the threat to
