May 28, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Howell, Vaupel, Sabo, Calley, Filler and Tate and referred to the Committee on Military, Veterans and Homeland Security.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 803j (MCL 257.803j), as amended by 1999 PA 183.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 803j. (1) A person who was a member of the armed services
 United States Armed Forces or a person whose spouse was a member of
- 3 the armed forces United States Armed Forces during the Korean War
- 4 may make application apply to the secretary of state for a special





- registration plate , which shall display that displays an
 appropriate vignette preceding the registration numbers and shall
 have has the word "veteran" inscribed beneath the registration
- 5 (2) Application for a special registration plate shall must be
 6 on a form prescribed by the secretary of state, and shall must be
 7 accompanied by any proof of the applicant or the applicant's spouse
 8 having been a Korean War veteran that the secretary of state may
 9 require. The application for a special registration plate shall
 10 also be accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee.
- 11 (3) Upon proper application, and payment of the \$5.00 service fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special 12 registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger 13 14 vehicle. A person who is disabled who makes application applies for 15 a special registration plate under this section and who makes 16 payment of the \$5.00 service fee shall must be issued a tab for persons with disabilities as provided in section 803f for his or 17 18 her special registration plate. The secretary of state shall 19 require the same proof that the applicant is a disabled person as 20 is required for issuance of a permanent windshield placard under section 675. A person issued 1 or more special registration plates 21 under subsection (1) shall must be assessed the applicable tax 22 23 provided in section 801.
 - (4) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.
- 27 (5) The special registration plate issued under this section
 28 shall expire expires on the birthday of the vehicle owner. When new
 29 plates are issued by the secretary of state, application for
