

SENATE BILL NO. 231

March 11, 2021, Introduced by Senator IRWIN and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to provide for the official time followed in this state; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. (1) If the United States Congress amends 15 USC 260a
2 to authorize states to observe daylight saving time year-round, it
3 is the intent of the legislature that daylight saving time shall be
4 the year-round standard time of this state and all of its political
5 subdivisions in that part of this state that is in the Eastern
6 Standard Time zone and in that part of this state that is in the

1 Central Standard Time zone.

2 (2) It is the intent of the legislature that the time change
3 described in subsection (1) take effect only if all of the
4 following states observe daylight saving time year-round:

5 (a) Wisconsin.

6 (b) Illinois.

7 (c) Indiana.

8 (d) Ohio.

9 (e) Pennsylvania.
