## **SENATE BILL NO. 602**

July 27, 2021, Introduced by Senators BARRETT, THEIS, NESBITT, RUNESTAD, BUMSTEAD, VICTORY, BIZON, DALEY, OUTMAN and VANDERWALL and referred to the Committee on Education and Career Readiness.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 5111a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 5111a. (1) Notwithstanding section 5111 or 9227 or any
- 2 other provision of this code, the department shall not promulgate
- 3 or enforce a rule requiring a child to receive an EUA vaccination,
- 4 wear a face mask, or be tested for COVID-19 if the child is
- 5 asymptomatic for COVID-19, to do any of the following:

- 1 (a) Enter or attend a school in this state.
- 2 (b) Ride a school bus or other school-related vehicle.
- 3 (c) Participate in or attend a school-sponsored activity or
- 4 event, whether or not it is held on school premises. A school-
- 5 sponsored activity or event described in this subdivision includes,
- 6 but is not limited to, participation in or attendance at school-
- 7 sponsored sports, band, theater, educational trips, or other
- 8 extracurricular activities.
- 9 (2) As used in this section:
- 10 (a) "COVID-19" means severe acute respiratory syndrome
- 11 coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2).
- 12 (b) "EUA vaccination" means a vaccine authorized by the United
- 13 States Food and Drug Administration solely for emergency use.
- 14 (c) "Face mask" means a tightly woven cloth or other
- 15 multilayer absorbent material that closely covers an individual's
- 16 mouth and nose.
- 17 (d) "School" means a public school or a nonpublic school as
- 18 those terms are defined in section 5 of the revised school code,
- 19 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.5.
- 20 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 21 unless Senate Bill No. 600 of the 101st Legislature is enacted into
