

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION C

January 27, 2021, Introduced by Senators IRWIN, CHANG and MOSS and referred to the Committee on Finance.

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to the state constitution of 1963, by amending section 7 of article IX, to provide for a graduated state income tax.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That the following amendment to the state constitution of 1963, to provide for a graduated state income tax, is proposed, agreed to, and submitted to the people of the state:

1 ARTICLE IX

2 Sec. 7. ~~No~~**An** income tax graduated as to rate or base ~~shall~~

1 **may** be imposed by the state ~~or any of its subdivisions.~~**but shall**
2 **not be imposed by any subdivision of the state.**

3 Resolved further, That the foregoing amendment shall be
4 submitted to the people of the state at the next general election
5 in the manner provided by law.
