Sec. 8e. (1) The department, in collaboration with the
department of education and the center for educational performance
and information, must provide a report to the house and senate
appropriation committees for the department budget, the house and
senate standing committees on human services, and the house and

- 1 senate fiscal agencies that must include all of the following:
- 2 (a) The total number of children in foster care identified by 3 grade of instruction.
- 4 (b) The number of children in foster care transferred to a different school district during the academic school year.
- 6 (c) The number of children in foster care who were suspended 7 or expelled from school during the academic school year.
- 8 (d) The number of children in foster care who are identified 9 by chronic absenteeism, truancy, or as drop-outs.
- 10 (e) The following broken down by public schools, public school
 11 academies, private schools, and schools at child caring
 12 institutions:
- 13 (i) Percentage of children in foster care who meet academic 14 standards on state standardized assessments.
- 15 (ii) Percentage of children in foster care who are receiving 16 alternative or special education services.
- 17 (iii) Percentage of children in foster care who are assigned to 18 advanced placement, early middle college, or dual enrollment.
- 19 (iv) Percentage of children in foster care who are assigned to 20 career and technical education.
- (v) Percentage of children in foster care, or who engaged in foster care in the last 5 years, who graduated or obtained a high school equivalency diploma.
- 24 (2) As used in this section, "child caring institution" means 25 that term as defined in section 1 of 1973 PA 116, MCL 722.111.
