**CONSTITUTION OF MICHIGAN OF 1963**

**§ 8 Quartering of soldiers.**

Sec. 8. No soldier shall, in time of peace, be quartered in any house without the consent of the owner or occupant, nor in time of war, except in a manner prescribed by law.
