## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION CC

A joint resolution to petition the congress of the United States to call a convention to propose amendments to the constitution of the United States to require a balanced federal budget.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
- 2 state of Michigan, That pursuant to article V of the constitution
- 3 of the United States, the legislature of the state of Michigan
- 4 petitions the congress of the United States of America, at its
- 5 session, to call a convention of the states limited to proposing an
- 6 amendment to the constitution of the United States requiring that
- 7 in the absence of a national emergency the total of all federal
- 8 appropriations made by the congress for any fiscal year may not

- 1 exceed the total of all estimated federal revenues for that fiscal
- 2 year, together with any related and appropriate fiscal restraints.
- Resolved further, That the legislature intends to provide by
- 4 law for the appointment of appointees to this convention of the
- 5 states which appointees shall participate in drafting rules,
- 6 bylaws, and procedural agreements that shall be used to govern the
- 7 convention of the states, in addition to other duties prescribed by
- 8 law.
- 9 Resolved further, That this application is to be considered as
- 10 covering the balanced budget amendment language of the presently
- 11 outstanding balanced budget applications from other states,
- 12 including, but not limited to, previously adopted applications from
- 13 Alabama, Alaska, Arkansas, Colorado, Delaware, Florida, Indiana,
- 14 Iowa, Kansas, Maryland, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, Nevada,
- 15 New Hampshire, New Mexico, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, and
- 16 Texas; and this application shall be aggregated with those
- 17 applications for the purpose of attaining the two-thirds of states
- 18 necessary to require the calling of a convention for proposing a
- 19 balanced budget amendment, but shall not be aggregated with any
- 20 applications on any other subject.
- 21 Resolved further, That this application constitutes a
- 22 continuing application in accordance with article V of the
- 23 constitution of the United States until the legislatures of at
- 24 least two-thirds of the several states have made applications on
- 25 the same subject. It supersedes all previous applications by this
- 26 legislature on the same subject.
- 27 Resolved further, That certified copies of this joint

- resolution be transmitted by the secretary of state to the 1
- president of the United States Senate, to the speaker of the United 2
- States House of Representatives, and to each member of this state's 3
- delegation to the congress and that printed copies be sent to each 4
- house of each state legislature in the United States. 5
