## HOUSE BILL NO. 4398

A bill to amend 2008 PA 551, entitled "Uniform securities act (2002),"

by amending section 410 (MCL 451.2410), as amended by 2012 PA 307.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 410. (1) Before October 1, 2015, 2019, a person shall pay
- 2 a fee of \$300.00 when initially filing an application for
- 3 registration as a broker-dealer and a fee of \$300.00 when filing a
- 4 renewal of registration as a broker-dealer. After September 30,
- 5 2015, 2019, a person shall pay a fee of \$250.00 when initially
- 6 filing an application for registration as a broker-dealer and a fee
- 7 of \$250.00 when filing a renewal of registration as a broker-
- 8 dealer. If the filing results in a denial or withdrawal, the
- 9 administrator shall retain all of the filing fee.
- 10 (2) Before October 1, <del>2015, 2019</del>, an individual shall pay a

- 1 fee of \$65.00 when filing an application for registration as an
- 2 agent, a fee of \$65.00 when filing a renewal of registration as an
- 3 agent, and a fee of \$65.00 when filing for a change of registration
- 4 as an agent. After September 30, <del>2015, 2019,</del> an individual shall
- 5 pay a fee of \$30.00 when filing an application for registration as
- 6 an agent, a fee of \$30.00 when filing a renewal of registration as
- 7 an agent, and a fee of \$30.00 when filing for a change of
- 8 registration as an agent. If the filing results in a denial or
- 9 withdrawal, the administrator shall retain all of the filing fee.
- 10 (3) Before October 1, 2015, 2019, a person shall pay a fee of
- 11 \$200.00 when filing an application for registration as an
- 12 investment adviser and a fee of \$200.00 when filing a renewal of
- 13 registration as an investment adviser. After September 30, 2015,
- 14 2019, a person shall pay a fee of \$150.00 when filing an
- 15 application for registration as an investment adviser and a fee of
- 16 \$150.00 when filing a renewal of registration as an investment
- 17 adviser. If the filing results in a denial or withdrawal, the
- 18 administrator shall retain all of the filing fee.
- 19 (4) Before October 1, <del>2015, 2019,</del> an individual shall pay a
- 20 fee of \$65.00 when filing an application for registration as an
- 21 investment adviser representative, a fee of \$65.00 when filing a
- 22 renewal of registration as an investment adviser representative,
- 23 and a fee of \$65.00 when filing a change of registration as an
- 24 investment adviser representative. After September 30, 2015, 2019,
- 25 an individual shall pay a fee of \$30.00 when filing an application
- 26 for registration as an investment adviser representative, a fee of
- 27 \$30.00 when filing a renewal of registration as an investment

- 1 adviser representative, and a fee of \$30.00 when filing a change of
- 2 registration as an investment adviser representative. If the filing
- 3 results in a denial or withdrawal, the administrator shall retain
- 4 all of the filing fee.
- 5 (5) Before October 1, <del>2015, 2019,</del> a federal covered investment
- 6 adviser required to file a notice under section 405 shall pay an
- 7 initial and annual notice fee of \$200.00. After September 30, 2015,
- 8 2019, a federal covered investment adviser required to file a
- 9 notice under section 405 shall pay an initial and annual notice fee
- **10** of \$150.00.
- 11 (6) A person that is required to pay a filing or notice fee
- 12 under this section may transmit the fee through or to a designee as
- 13 a rule or order requires under this act.
- 14 (7) An investment adviser representative who is registered as
- 15 an agent under section 402 and who represents a person that is both
- 16 registered as a broker-dealer under section 401 and registered as
- 17 an investment adviser under section 403 or required as a federal
- 18 covered investment adviser to make a notice filing under section
- 19 405 is not required to pay an initial or annual registration fee
- 20 for registration as an investment adviser representative.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect October
- **22** 1, 2015.
