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## **HOUSE BILL No. 4582**

May 12, 2015, Introduced by Rep. Tedder and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending sections 17001 and 17501 (MCL 333.17001 and 333.17501), as amended by 2006 PA 161, and by adding sections 17011a and 17511a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 17001. (1) As used in this part:
- 2 (a) "Academic institution" means either of the following:
- 3 (i) A medical school approved by the board.
  - (ii) A hospital licensed under article 17 that meets all of the following requirements:
  - (A) Was the sole sponsor or a co-sponsor, if each other cosponsor is either a medical school approved by the board or a hospital owned by the federal government and directly operated by

- 1 the United States department of veterans' affairs, of not less than
- 2 4 postgraduate education residency programs approved by the board
- 3 under section 17031(1) for not less than the 3 years immediately
- 4 preceding the date of an application for a limited license under
- 5 section 16182(2)(c) or an application for a full license under
- 6 section 17031(2), provided that at least 1 of the residency
- 7 programs is in the specialty area of medical practice, or in a
- 8 specialty area that includes the subspecialty of medical practice,
- 9 in which the applicant for a limited license proposes to practice
- 10 or in which the applicant for a full license has practiced for the
- 11 hospital.
- 12 (B) Has spent not less than \$2,000,000.00 for medical
- 13 education during each of the 3 years immediately preceding the date
- 14 of an application for a limited license under section 16182(2)(c)
- or an application for a full license under section 17031(2). As
- 16 used in this subparagraph, "medical education" means the education
- 17 of physicians and candidates for degrees or licenses to become
- 18 physicians, including, but not limited to, physician staff,
- 19 residents, interns, and medical students.
- 20 (b) "Electrodiagnostic studies" means the testing of
- 21 neuromuscular functions utilizing nerve conduction tests and needle

- 8 (f) "Practice of medicine" means the diagnosis, treatment,
- 9 prevention, cure, or relieving of a human disease, ailment, defect,
- 10 complaint, or other physical or mental condition, by attendance,
- 11 advice, device, diagnostic test, or other means, or offering,
- 12 undertaking, attempting to do, or holding oneself out as able to
- 13 do, any of these acts.
- 14 (g) "Practice as a physician's assistant" means the practice
- 15 of medicine, osteopathic medicine and surgery, or podiatric
- 16 medicine and surgery performed under the supervision of a physician
- 17 or podiatrist licensed under this article.
- (h) "Supervision" means that term as defined in section 16109,
- 19 except that it also includes the existence of a predetermined plan
- 20 for emergency situations, including, but not limited to, the
- 21 designation of a physician to supervise a physician's assistant in
- 22 the absence of the primary supervising physician.
- 23 (i) "Task force" means the joint task force created in section

- 2 SEC. 17011A. (1) AN ALLOPATHIC PHYSICIAN WHO HOLDS AN
- 3 EXPEDITED LICENSE UNDER THE INTERSTATE MEDICAL LICENSURE COMPACT IS
- 4 AUTHORIZED TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF MEDICINE UNDER THIS
- 5 ARTICLE.
- 6 (2) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE, INCLUDING THE OBLIGATIONS OF
