A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

- Sec. 5119. (1) An individual WHO IS applying for a marriage

- 1 license shall be advised through the distribution of written
- 2 educational materials by the county clerk regarding prenatal care
- 3 and the transmission and prevention of venereal disease and HIV
- 4 infection. The written educational materials shall describe the
- 5 availability to the applicant of tests for both venereal disease
- 6 and HIV infection. The information shall include a list of
- 7 locations where HIV counseling and testing services funded by the
- 8 department are available. The written educational materials shall
- 9 be approved or prepared by the department.
- 10 (2) A county clerk shall not issue a marriage license to an
