SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 4750

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 193 (MCL 168.193), as amended by 2012 PA 276.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 193. (1) To obtain the printing of the name of a person
- 2 as a candidate for nomination by a political party for an office
- 3 named in section 191 under a particular party heading upon the
- 4 official primary ballots, there shall MUST be filed with the county
- 5 clerk nominating petitions signed by a number of qualified and
- 6 registered electors residing within the county as determined under
- 7 section 544f. Nominating petitions shall MUST be in the form
- 8 prescribed in section 544c. Until December 31, 2013, the county
- 9 clerk shall receive nominating petitions up to 4 p.m. of the
- 10 twelfth Tuesday before the August primary. Beginning January 1,

- 1 2014, the THE county clerk shall receive nominating petitions up to
- 2 4 p.m. of the fifteenth Tuesday before the August primary.
- 3 (2) To obtain the printing of the name of a candidate of a
- 4 political party under the particular party's heading upon the
- 5 primary election ballots in the various voting precincts of the
- 6 county, there may be filed by the candidate, in lieu of filing
- 7 nomination petitions, a NONREFUNDABLE filing fee of \$100.00 to be
- 8 paid to the county clerk. Payment of the fee and certification of
- 9 the candidate's name paying the fee shall be ARE governed by the
- 10 same provisions as in the case of nominating petitions. The fee
- 11 shall MUST be deposited in the general fund of the county. and
- 12 shall be refunded to candidates who are nominated and to an equal
- 13 number of candidates who receive the next highest number of votes
- 14 in the primary election. If 2 or more candidates tie in having the
- 15 lowest number of votes allowing a refund, the sum of \$100.00 shall
- 16 be divided among them. The deposits of all other defeated
- 17 candidates, as well as the deposits of candidates who withdraw or
- 18 are disqualified, shall be forfeited and the candidates shall be
- 19 notified of the forfeiture. Deposits forfeited under this section
- 20 shall be paid into and credited to the general fund of the county.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 22 after the date it is enacted into law.
