4 Sec. 14703. Within 48 hours after the end of a fire or other
5 incident at which an organized fire department uses firefighting
6 foam containing intentionally added PFAS, the fire chief shall
7 report the incident to the Michigan pollution emergency alert
8 system.

9 Sec. 14705. The department shall establish a collection
10 program for firefighting foam concentrate containing intentionally
11 added PFAS and establish guidelines for the program. Under the
12 program, the department shall accept the foam concentrate free of
13 charge and properly dispose of the foam concentrate. The program is
14 contingent on legislative appropriations to cover program costs.

15 Sec. 14707. (1) A person that violates section 14703 may be
16 ordered to pay the following civil fines:

17 (a) If the fire chief fails to file a report within 48 hours
18 after a fire or other incident, \$50.00.

19 (b) If the fire chief fails to file a report within 72 hours
20 after the fire or other incident, \$100.00.

21 (c) If the fire chief fails to file a report within 96 hours
22 after the fire or other incident, \$250.00.

23 (d) If the fire chief fails to file a report within 120 hours
24 after the fire or other incident, \$500.00.

25 (2) A violation of section 14703 may be prosecuted by the
26 prosecutor of the county in which the violation occurred.
