

**SUBSTITUTE FOR  
HOUSE BILL NO. 5341**

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled  
"Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"  
by amending section 407 (MCL 436.1407).

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 407. (1) The commission shall grant a brewpub license to  
2 a person ~~who,~~**that**, in addition to complying with section 405, does  
3 all of the following:

4           (a) Pays the fee as prescribed in section 525.

5           (b) Provides evidence to the commission that not less than 25%  
6 of the gross sales of the restaurant during the 1-year licensure  
7 period are derived from the sale of food and nonalcoholic beverages  
8 prepared for consumption on the premises.

9           (c) Complies with section 405(3) ~~through (8).~~**to (7).**



1 (2) The commission shall renew a brewpub license of a person  
2 who does all of the following:

3 (a) Pays the fee as prescribed in section 525.

4 (b) Provides evidence to the commission that not less than 25%  
5 of the gross sales of the restaurant during the 1-year licensure  
6 period are derived from the sale of food and nonalcoholic beverages  
7 prepared for consumption on the premises.

8 (c) Complies with section 405(3) ~~through (8)~~ to (7).

9 (3) The commission shall revoke a brewpub license if, during  
10 the 1-year licensure period, less than 25% of the gross sales of  
11 the restaurant are derived from the sale of food and nonalcoholic  
12 beverages prepared for consumption on the premises.

13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
