## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5408

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled "The social welfare act,"

by amending section 109f (MCL 400.109f), as amended by 2017 PA 224.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 109f. (1) The department shall support the use of
- 2 Medicaid funds for specialty services and supports for eligible
- 3 Medicaid beneficiaries with a serious mental illness, developmental
- 4 disability, serious emotional disturbance, or substance use
- 5 disorder. Medicaid-covered specialty services and supports shall be
- 6 managed and delivered by specialty prepaid health plans chosen by
- 7 the department. The specialty services and supports shall must be
- 8 carved out from the basic Medicaid health care benefits package.
  - (2) Specialty prepaid health plans are Medicaid managed care

- 15 related to a primary diagnosis of alcohol use disorder as specified
- 16 in the most recent diagnostic and statistical manual of mental
- 17 disorders published by the American Psychiatric Association. When a
- 18 Medicaid beneficiary has a primary diagnosis of alcohol use
- 19 disorder, the health care provider with prescriptive authority
- 20 under the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.1101 to
- 21 333.25211, or nonphysician practitioner qualifies for fee-for-
- 22 service reimbursement for services including, but not limited to,
- 23 evaluation and management services, and consultation services.
- 24 (5) As used in this section, "nonphysician practitioner" means
- 25 an individual licensed or certified in this state to provide
- 26 nonphysician behavioral health services including, but not limited
- 27 to, behavioral health services identified in the department's
- 28 behavioral health fee schedule.
