## HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 783

A bill to amend 1915 PA 31, entitled "Youth tobacco act,"

(MCL 722.641 to 722.645) by adding section 1a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1a. (1) A person who sells vapor products at retail shall not do any of the following:
- 3 (a) Advertise a vapor product to a minor or in a manner that 4 violates the family smoking prevention and tobacco control act,
- 5 Public Law 111-31.
- 6 (b) Give away a free sample of a vapor product, including any 7 component or part of the vapor product.
- 8 (c) Sell or distribute a vapor product without a health 9 warning statement on the package of the vapor product.





- 1 (d) Display an advertisement for a vapor product that is not 2 accompanied with a health warning statement about the vapor 3 product.
- 4 (2) A person who violates subsection (1) is responsible for a state civil infraction and may be ordered to pay a civil fine as follows:
- 7 (a) For a first offense in a calendar year, not more than 8 \$500.00.
- 9 (b) For a second offense in a calendar year, not more than 10 \$1,000.00.
- 11 (c) For a third or subsequent offense in a calendar year, not 12 more than \$2,500.00.
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect unless all of the following bills of the 100th Legislature are enacted into law:
- 16 (a) Senate Bill No. 781.
- 17 (b) Senate Bill No. 782.
- 18 (c) Senate Bill No. 784.
- 19 (d) House Bill No. 4039.
