- 7 (a) A tent which that may be occupied or furnished for public
- 8 assembly by 50 or more people.
- 9 (b) A tent in which animals are stabled for public exhibition





- 1 or sale.
- 2 (c) A tent located within a building used by the public.
- 3 (d) All tarpaulins and decorative material used in connection4 with any of the above.
- 5 (2) A safety net or tent used for recreational camping is6 exempt from this section.
- 7 (3) After October 1, 1975, all camping tentage of new
 8 manufacture sold in this state shall comply with the provisions for
 9 resistance to fire as prescribed in the specification for flame10 resistant materials used in camping tentage, canvas products
 11 association international-84, 1974, or another nationally
 12 recognized standard that is acceptable to the director.
- 13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days 14 after the date it is enacted into law.
