SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5284

A bill to amend 2018 PA 175, entitled "Insurance provider assessment act," by amending section 13 (MCL 550.1763).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 13. (1) All money received and collected under this act shall must be deposited by the department in the insurance provider fund established in this section.
 - (2) The insurance provider fund is created within the state treasury and shall must be administered by the department for auditing purposes.
- 7 (3) The state treasurer may receive money or other assets from
 8 any source for deposit into the fund. The state treasurer shall
 9 direct the investment of the fund. The state treasurer shall credit



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- 1 to the fund interest and earnings from fund investments.

 - (b) (d)—To pay administrative and compliance costs in accordance with section 15.
 - (c) For the state fiscal year ending September 30, 2025, \$6,000,000.00 to the health data utility selected under section 2508 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.2508.
 - (d) For the state fiscal year ending September 30, 2026, \$7,000,000.00 to the health data utility selected under section 2508 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.2508.
 - (e) For the state fiscal year ending September 30, 2027, and each subsequent state fiscal year, \$8,000,000.00 to the health data utility selected under section 2508 of the public health code, 1978

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- 1 PA 368, MCL 333.2508. Beginning January 1, 2028, and each January 1
- 2 after that date, the state treasurer shall adjust the amount under
- 3 this subdivision in accordance with the Consumer Price Index. As
- 4 used in this subdivision, "Consumer Price Index" means the annual
- 5 average percentage change in the Detroit Consumer Price Index for
- 6 all items for the prior 12-month period as reported by the United
- 7 States Department of Labor.
- 8 (f) (e) The balance of the fund remaining after the
- 9 appropriations described in subdivisions (a) , (b), (c), and
