## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5889

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1509.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1509. (1) The department shall provide to school 2 districts, intermediate school districts, and public school 3 academies a notice containing information regarding section 213b of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.213b. The notice from 4 the department must contain information about the requirements of 5 6 this section, a copy of or a link to section 213b of the Michigan 7 penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.213b, and contact information for the office of school safety within the department of state police 8 9 for questions about section 213b of the Michigan penal code, 1931

- 2 action that arises out of the notice provided in this subsection.
- 3 (2) School districts, intermediate school districts, and
- 4 public school academies shall provide the notice described in
- 5 subsection (1) to all of the following individuals:
- 6 (a) School personnel employed by or at a school operated by
- 7 the school district, intermediate school district, or public school
- 8 academy.
- 9 (b) Students who are in any of grades 6 to 12 and who are
- 10 enrolled in the school district, intermediate school district, or
- 11 public school academy.
- 12 (c) Parents and legal guardians of the students described in
- 13 subdivision (b).
- 14 (3) The board of a school district or intermediate school
- 15 district or board of directors of a public school academy shall
- 16 implement a policy to educate the individuals described in
- 17 subsection (2) about section 213b of the Michigan penal code, 1931
- 18 PA 328, MCL 750.213b.
- 19 (4) The board of a school district or intermediate school
- 20 district or board of directors of a public school academy shall
- 21 hold at least 1 board meeting each school year to share free
- 22 educational materials on sextortion from the National Center for
- 23 Missing and Exploited Children, the Federal Bureau of
- 24 Investigation, or the Office for Victims of Crime.
- 25 (5) As used in this section, "sextortion" means a form of
- 26 child sexual exploitation in which an individual threatens an
- 27 individual who is less than 18 years of age with the possibility of
- 28 sharing a nude or sexual image of the individual who is less than
- 29 18 years of age with the public and demands additional sexual

- 1 content, sexual activity, or money from the individual who is less 2 than 18 years of age.
- 3 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect 4 unless House Bill No. 5887 of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into
- 5 law.
