

HOUSE BILL No. 5256

October 14, 1991, Introduced by Reps. Harder, Bartnik, DeMars, Munsell and Byrum and referred to the Committee on Tourism, Fisheries and Wildlife.

A bill to amend the title and sections 1 and 2 of Act No. 1 of the Local Acts of 1937, entitled

"An act to prevent hunting for game on Sunday, in the county of Livingston; to authorize the arrest of persons violating the provisions of this act, and to prescribe the penalty therefor, and to repeal Act number two hundred seventy-three of the Session Laws of nineteen hundred five; and to provide a referendum thereon,"

and to provide for a referendum.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. The title and sections 1 and 2 of Act No. 1 of
2 the Local Acts of 1937 are amended to read as follows:

3 TITLE

4 An act to prevent hunting for game on Sunday ON PUBLIC
5 LANDS, in the county of Livingston; to authorize the arrest of
6 persons violating the provisions of this act, and to prescribe
7 the penalty therefor, and to repeal Act number two hundred

1 seventy-three of the Session Laws of nineteen hundred five; and
2 to provide a referendum thereon.

3 ~~Section~~ SEC. 1. It ~~shall be~~ IS unlawful for any person
4 or persons, whether residents of this or any other state, to hunt
5 for game with firearms, or dogs on Sunday on any PUBLIC lands or
6 PUBLIC premises in the county of Livingston of this state.

7 Sec. 2. The possession by any person or persons of firearms
8 on any PUBLIC lands or PUBLIC premises in Livingston county on
9 Sunday ~~shall be deemed~~ IS prima facie evidence of a violation
10 of this act.

11 Section 2. (1) This amendatory act shall not take effect
12 until it is submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of the
13 county of Livingston and ratified by a majority of the electors
14 voting on the question. The question of the adoption of this
15 amendatory act shall be submitted to the voters of the county at
16 the next general election, after the passage of this amendatory
17 act, and like notice of the submission shall be given as is
18 required by law in the case of elections to elect county offi-
19 cers, and shall be submitted in substantially the following
20 form:

5 (2) The result of the vote shall be canvassed by the board
6 of state canvassers.

7 (3) If a majority of the electors voting on the question, as
8 determined by the canvass of votes cast, vote in favor of the
9 adoption of this amendatory act, it shall become effective 10
10 days following the certification of the election results.
