**LEADER DOG ACCESS**

**A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4052 AS INTRODUCED 1-11-95**

The Penal Code prohibits denying access to public accommodations or private housing to handicapped people accompanied by guide dogs. House Bill 4052 would extend this provision to people who are training guide or leader dogs and are accompanied by the dogs in places of public or private housing or accommodation. Under the bill, a trainer would have to have in his or her possession picture identification indicating that he or she was employed by a organization that trains guide or leader dogs.
