A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4478 AS INTRODUCED 2-28-95

The McCauley-Traxler-Law-Bowman-McNeely Lottery Act requires that the lottery commissioner promulgate rules on, among other things, the type of lottery that may be conducted, and the type or types of locations at which tickets or shares may be sold. House Bill 4478 would amend the act to require that the commissioner, when determining the location of lottery terminals, take into account with equal emphasis the total instant game sales for the three months preceding a market evaluation, and the need to maximize net lottery revenues from the total number of terminals placed.
