A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4827 AS INTRODUCED 5-16-95

The Library Privacy Act says that a library record is not subject to the disclosure requirements of the Freedom of Information Act. Unless ordered by a court subsequent to a hearing, a library or an employee or an agent of a library cannot release or disclose a library record or portion of a library record without the written consent of the person identified in the record. <u>House Bill 4827</u> would amend the act to require, for release or disclosure, the written consent of the person "liable for payment for or return of the materials identified in that library record."
