A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5408 INTRODUCED 11-9-95

Currently, under the Department of Corrections enabling act, as soon as a prisoner arrives at a reception center of a state correctional facility, he or she is tested for HIV (the human immunodeficiency virus). If a prisoner tests positive, the positive test results are reported to the Department of Public Health. The bill would amend the act to require, in addition, that each correctional officer employed at the facility where the prisoner was housed also be notified.
