ENROLLED SENATE BILL No. 327

AN ACT to make appropriations for the department of environmental quality for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996; to provide for the expenditure of those appropriations; to create funds and accounts; to prescribe certain powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials; to authorize certain transfers and adjustments by certain state agencies; and to provide for the disposition of fees and other income received by the various state agencies.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of environmental quality for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, from the following funds:

GENERAL SECTIONS

Sec. 201. The funds appropriated in section 101 to the department of environmental quality from the Michigan underground storage tank financial assurance fund for the purpose of carrying out the duties and responsibilities as specified in part 215 (underground storage tank financial assurance) of the natural resources and environmental protection act, Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, being sections 324.21501 to 324.21551 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are considered work project appropriations and any unencumbered funds are carried forward into the succeeding fiscal year. The following is in compliance with section 451(3) of the management and budget act, Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984, being section 18.1451 of the Michigan Compiled Laws:

(a) The purpose of the projects to be carried forward is to carry out the responsibilities of part 215 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994.

(b) The projects will be accomplished by contract and state employees.

(c) The total estimated cost is identified in a line-item appropriation.

(d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 1997.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
