

HOUSE BILL No. 4036

January 11, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Profit and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend section 367 of Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984, entitled as amended
"The management and budget act,"
as amended by Act No. 504 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section 18.1367 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 367 of Act No. 431 of the Public Acts of 2 1984, as amended by Act No. 504 of the Public Acts of 1988, being 3 section 18.1367 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read 4 as follows:
- 5 Sec. 367. (1) Concurrent with transmitting the state budget
- 6 to the legislature, the governor shall submit to the legislature
- 7 and the senate and house fiscal agencies executive budget bills
- 8 containing individual line item amounts, including the number of
- 9 FTE positions to be funded by each individual line item amount,

- 1 for the proposed expenditures and any necessary bills for
- 2 additional revenue to provide financing for the proposed
- 3 expenditures. One executive budget bill and 1 enacted budget
- 4 bill shall contain all of the following:
- 5 (a) The estimated revenue for each state operating fund in
- 6 sufficient detail to provide for comparison with actual revenue.
- 7 (b) Summary totals for each state operating fund to reflect
- 8 that recommended expenditures for each fund are within proposed
- 9 and estimated resources.
- 10 (c) An itemized statement of state spending to be paid to
- 11 units of local government, total state spending from state
- 12 sources of financing, and the state-local proportion derived from
- 13 that data.
- 14 (2) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (1), BEGINNING WITH THE
- 15 1995-96 STATE FISCAL YEAR THE STATE BUDGET SHALL BE ENACTED IN 1
- 16 BUDGET BILL. THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT
- 17 THE ENACTMENT OF BILLS SUPPLEMENTING THE CURRENT YEAR'S OPERATION
- 18 ENACTED IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 31 OF ARTICLE IV OF THE STATE
- 19 CONSTITUTION OF 1963.
