

HOUSE BILL No. 4324

February 7, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Johnson, Cropsey and Nye and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for a capital outlay program; to set forth the provisions for its implementation within the budgetary process; to make appropriations for planning and construction at state agencies; to provide for the purchase of furnishings and equipment relative to occupancy of a project; to prescribe powers and duties of certain state officers and agencies; to prescribe standards and conditions relating to the appropriations; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

- Sec. 201. As used in this act:
- 23 (a) "Department" means the department of management and budget.
- (b) "Director" means the director of the department of management
- 25 and budget.

- 1 (c) "JCOS" means the joint capital outlay subcommittee of the
- 2 appropriations committees.
- 3 (d) "State agency" means an agency of state government. State
- 4 agency does not include a community college or university.
- 5 (e) "State building authority" means the building authority created
- 6 under Act No. 183 of the Public Acts of 1964, being sections 830.411 to
- 7 830.425 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 8 Sec. 202. Sites identified in section 101 of this act are prelimi-
- 9 nary and may be changed at the recommendation of the Michigan department
- 10 of corrections upon notification to JCCS.
- 11 Sec. 203. This act is subject to the management and budget act, Act
- 12 No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984, being sections 18.1101 to 18.1594 of
- 13 the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 14 Sec. 204. (1) The appropriation in section 101 for additional hous-
- 15 ing units at existing facilities includes facilities at the following
- 16 locations:
- Alger (total cost not to exceed \$4,106,700, state building authority
- 18 share \$4,065,700, state general fund share \$41,000)
- Baraga (2 units) (total cost not to exceed \$8,113,300, state build-
- 20 ing authority share \$8,032,200, state general fund share \$81,100)
- 21 Oaks (2 units) (total cost not to exceed \$8,113,300, state building
- 22 authority share \$8,032,200, state general fund share \$81,100)
- 23 Standish (total cost not to exceed \$4,106,700, state building
- 24 authority share \$4,065,700, state general fund share \$41,100)
- 25 IMAX (total cost not to exceed \$2,278,000, state building authority
- 26 share \$2,255,200, state general fund share \$22,800)

- 1 Lakeland (total cost not to exceed \$10,100,000, state building
- 2 authority share \$9,999,000, state general fund share \$101,000)
- 3 Parole Camp (total cost not to exceed \$12,340,000, state building
- 4 authority share \$12,216,600, state general fund share \$123,400)
- 5 (2) Costs identified in subsection (1) may be shifted between loca-
- 6 tions upon notification to JCOS provided that overall costs do not exceed
- 7 those identified in section 101 and that the number of facilities that
- 8 are identified in subsection (1) are constructed.
- 9 (3) These additional housing units will be constructed in accordance
- 10 with standards used previously for pole facility construction.
- 11 Sec. 205. The department shall notify the JCOS upon determination
- 12 of the site for the Michigan youth correctional facility.
- 13 Sec. 206. Funding available in the existing authorization for the
- 14 western Wayne correctional facility may be used for furnishings and
- 15 related expenditures associated with double-bunking at western Wayne.
