

HOUSE BILL No. 5049

September 14, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Brewer, Hanley, Olshove, Dobronski, Hertel, Yokich, Voorhees, DeHart, Jaye, Leland and Llewellyn and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled as amended

"Revised judicature act of 1961,"

as amended, being sections 600.101 to 600.9947 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 1428.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, as
 amended, being sections 600.101 to 600.9947 of the Michigan
 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 1428 to read as
 follows:

5 SEC. 1428. (1) THE CIRCUIT AND DISTRICT COURTS SHALL USE
6 VIDEO RECORDING DEVICES FOR MAKING THE RECORD OF TRIAL COURT PRO7 CEEDINGS, AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

8 (2) NOT LATER THAN 6 MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS9 SECTION, EACH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OR JUDICIAL DISTRICT THAT HAS 4 OR

1 MORE JUDGES SHALL USE A VIDEO RECORDING DEVICE TO MAKE THE RECORD 2 OF TRIAL COURT PROCEEDINGS IN AT LEAST 1 COURTROOM.

(3) EACH CIRCUIT JUDGE OR DISTRICT JUDGE ELECTED AFTER THE 3 4 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION TO HIS OR HER FIRST TERM IN OFFICE 5 SHALL USE A VIDEO RECORDING DEVICE TO MAKE THE RECORDS OF TRIAL 6 COURT PROCEEDINGS IN HIS OR HER COURTROOM.
