



HOUSE BILL No. 5492

December 14, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Law, Bush, Llewellyn and Bullard and referred to the Committee on Insurance.

A bill to amend the title of Act No. 323 of the Public Acts of 1984, entitled "The health care false claim act," being sections 752.1001 to 752.1011 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 8a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. The title of Act No. 323 of the Public Acts of
2 1984, being sections 752.1001 to 752.1011 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended and section 8a is added to read as
4 follows:

5 TITLE

6 An act to prohibit fraud in the obtaining of benefits or
7 payments in connection with health care coverage and insurance;
8 to prohibit kickbacks or bribes in connection with such coverage
9 and insurance; to prohibit conspiracies in obtaining benefits or

1 payments; to provide for certain powers and duties of certain
2 state and local officers and agencies; to provide for AND
3 PRECLUDE certain civil actions; and to prescribe penalties.

4 SEC. 8A. IF ACTING IN GOOD FAITH, A PERSON IS NOT SUBJECT
5 TO CIVIL LIABILITY FOR PROVIDING INFORMATION, INVESTIGATING, OR
6 COOPERATING WITH AN INVESTIGATION OR EXAMINATION UNDER THIS ACT.
