



HOUSE BILL No. 5786

April 23, 1996, Introduced by Reps. Horton, Jersevic, Gernaat, Ryan, London, Fitzgerald, McBryde, Cropsey, McManus, Bobier, Hammerstrom, Kaza, Rhead, Goschka, Voorhees, Green, Lowe, Byl, Oxender, Rocca and Perricone and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 222 of the Public Acts of 1972, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for an official personal identification card; to provide for its form, issuance and use; to provide for certain duties of the secretary of state; and to prescribe certain penalties for violations,"

being section 28.291 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 222 of the Public Acts of
2 1972, being section 28.291 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 1. A person who is a resident of this state AND WHO
5 IS EITHER A UNITED STATES CITIZEN OR AN ALIEN LAWFULLY PRESENT IN
6 THE UNITED STATES may apply to the department of state for an
7 official state personal identification card. Upon application,
8 the applicant shall supply a birth certificate attesting to his

1 OR HER age or other sufficient documents or identification as the
2 secretary of state may require. IF THE SECRETARY OF STATE HAS
3 REASONABLE CAUSE TO BELIEVE THAT THE PERSON HAS PROVIDED FALSE
4 DOCUMENTATION AND THAT THE PERSON MAY BE AN ILLEGAL ALIEN, THE
5 SECRETARY OF STATE MAY REPORT THAT FACT TO THE UNITED STATES
6 IMMIGRATION AND NATURALIZATION SERVICE.
